Parking During a Snowstorm

Residents must obey all no parking signs and winter parking ban restrictions set forth in **Section 284-53** of the City code that addresses winter parking on City streets. From the 30th day of November at 11:00 p.m. to the following 31st day of March at 12:00 midnight, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. upon any public street in the City without special permission, in writing, to be granted by the Chief of Police or his designee.

What should I do if my vehicle was ticketed or towed for being illegally parked on the street during the winter parking ban?

The Police Department coordinates all towing operations. If you find that your vehicle has been towed, contact the Police Department non-emergency number at (518) 773-4514.
