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**ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_**

Intro O-1

Councilmember       Simonds       presented the following Ordinance and moved its adoption:

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**ORDINANCE MODIFYING GLOVERSVILLE CITY CODE SECTION 300-44.1(K) TO PERMIT ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARDS (EMB) AND LIGHT EMITTING DIODE (LED) ILLUMINATION IN CERTAIN ZONING DISTRICTS**

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**WHEREAS**, the Gloversville Economic Development and Planning Committee having recommended to the Common Council to make certain amendments to the City Code to allow for Electronic Message Boards (EMB) and Light Emitting Diode (LED) in non-residential zoning districts of the City of Gloversville; and

**WHEREAS**, it is agreed that Gloversville City Code, Section 300-44.1 (K) is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Subject to the limitations set forth in sub-paragraph 2 of this section, No sign shall be illuminated by or contain flashing, intermittent, rotating or moving lights except to show time and temperature, or barber poles.
2. In Residence-Commercial (R-C), Commercial (C-1), Manufacturing (M-1) and (M-2), Industrial Park Zone (IPZ), and Crossroads Industrial Park Zone (CIP) zoning districts of the City, one EMB or LED sign/light per business property shall be permitted provided that all of the following criteria are met:
  - a. The EMB or LED sign shall be erected as either a wall/façade sign or monument/ground sign;
  - b. The EMB or LED sign shall not exceed 24 square feet in sign display area on either side of the sign;
  - c. In no case shall the total square footage of any EMB or LED sign exceed 48 square feet;
  - d. There shall be no scrolling, flashing, or animation of any message or any portion thereof;
  - e. Any message shall be limited to the name and nature of the business;
  - f. No political or personal views or endorsements shall be contained in any message;
  - g. The static display time of each changeable message or image shall be a minimum of 20 seconds in duration;
  - h. The maximum length of time between change of messages or images shall be 20 seconds;
  - i. Any change of message or image shall occur simultaneously for the entire sign;
  - j. During daylight hours, the maximum illumination shall be 5,000 nits. Between dusk and dawn, the maximum illumination shall be 500 nits;
  - k. In R-C zoning districts, the sign shall not interfere with neighboring properties and the rights of neighbors to enjoy their property.

This Ordinance amending City Code, Section 300-44.1 (K) shall be effective upon ratification by the Common Council following the conclusion of a Public Hearing held on October 13, 2015.

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**ORDINANCE AMENDING GLOVERSVILLE CITY CODE**  
**SECTION 102-30 REGARDING ELECTRICAL PERMITS**

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1. Amendment :

Gloversville City Code, Section 102.30 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. Inspections and approvals. No person, firm or corporation shall perform any work on any electrical system until an application for inspection has been filed with the Electrical Inspector pursuant to the rules and regulations adopted by the New York Board of Fire Underwriters, the New York Atlantic Inland Inc., the Middle Department Inspection Agency Inc., Independent Consolidated Inspection Services, the Commonwealth Electrical Inspection Service Inc., The Inspector LLC, Northeast Electrical Inspections, LLC.
- B. Any person, firm or corporation shall comply with any other rule or regulation that has been duly adopted and is necessary for the Electrical Inspector and the New York Board of Fire Underwriters, the New York Atlantic Inland Inc., the Middle Department Inspection Agency Inc., and Independent Consolidated Inspection Services, the Commonwealth Electrical Inspection Service Inc., The Inspector LLC, Northeast Electrical Inspections, LLC.

2. Effectiveness of Amendment: This Ordinance amending Gloversville City Code, Section 102.30 shall be effective upon ratification by the Common Council following the conclusion of a Public Hearing to be held on October 13, 2015.
