Intro R-1

Councilmember _____ presented the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL AID AND NEW YORK STATE MARCHISELLI AID FOR A BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDING

WHEREAS, the project for the bridge replacement of Hill Street/Cayadutta Creek (BIN 2204120), City of Gloversville, Fulton County, P.I.N. 2754.24 (“the project”) is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gloversville desires to advance the project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-Federal share of the costs of the total project.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$1,643,000 is hereby appropriated and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that in the event the full Federal and non-Federal share costs of the project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the City Council shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon notification by the Department thereof, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Gloversville is hereby authorized to execute all necessary agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal aid and/or Marchiselli aid on behalf of the City of Gloversville with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the project and provide for the administration of the project and the municipality’s first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of Federal aid and State aid eligible project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and be it further,

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary agreement in connection with this project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
