**ORDINANCE AMENDING GLOVERSVILLE CITY CODE SECTION 284, SECTION 81
ADDING A NUMBER OF NO PARKING AREAS**

Section 1.

Section 284-81, Schedule VI: Parking or Standing Prohibited At All Times. In accordance with Section 284-52, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time park or stand a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

Permanent Changes to City Parking with Various Specifications

- Fifth Avenue
No parking on even numbered side from N. Main & Yale and from Kingsboro to the City line
- Sixth Avenue
No parking even side between Kingsboro Avenue and East Boulevard
- Summer Street
Between N. McNab & Western Blvd: No parking on even numbered side
One way east bound traffic during arrival/dismissal at McNab School
