2018 SUMMER CLEAN-UP

PROGRAM

THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS WILL AGAIN BE RUNNING A CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP PROGRAM TO ENABLE CITY RESIDENTS TO DISPOSE OF UNWANTED ITEMS, FREE OF CHARGE.

- 1. THERE WILL BE A DROP-OFF SITE BEHIND THE TRANSIT FACILITY ON WEST FULTON STREET ON THE FOLLOWING DATES:** May 12-13, June 9-10, July 14-15, August 11-12, September 8-9 and October 13-14. Saturday hours will be from 8am– 3pm and Sunday from 8am - Noon. Proof of residency will be required. There will be a limit of 3 loads per weekend per vehicle. No hazardous materials or household trash eligible for weekly pickup may be brought to the drop-off site.
- 2. Beginning Wednesday, May 2nd, bulk pickups will resume in each Ward. These will occur as follows:** Ward 1-May, Ward 2-June, Ward 3-July, Ward 4-August, Ward 5-September, Ward 6-October. Household items will be collected from terraces on Wednesdays ONLY. Please limit the size of the pile to 5'x5'x10'. Electronics should be separated from the rest of the household items. **THERE WILL NOT BE ANY BULK PICKUPS ON 5/30, 7/4, 9/5 OR 10/10 DUE TO FEDERAL HOLIDAYS.**
- 3. Residents will also be able to SCHEDULE A BULK PICK-UP at times apart from the above mentioned for \$45 (for a 5'x5'x10' pile), payable in advance at the City Clerk's office. For appliance pick up only, a sticker may be purchased from the City Clerk's office for \$10 and the Department of Public Works will remove the appliance from the terrace.**
